

## Location for Firm Orders

Priority for assigning location when ordering:

- bibliographer specifies in Oasis, or on paper lists & orders  
(if the bibliographer does specify a location other than the fund-driven one, the order record must contain an internal note explaining this, eg: loc=nor per Kahn)
- fund-driven location using chart below  
A&S startup funds (7-funds) and gift funds (2- or 3-funds) assumed to be norst, unless other location specified by bibliographer (either as a default, or in each order).

Note: Coutts approval books are charged to vrtmo; locations are set by the profiles (but can be modified by the bibliographers) and come in automatically when records are imported.

### **Call number exceptions to norst location**

Because there is no space assigned in the Norlin stacks to the following call number ranges, books received and cataloged in these ranges need to have their location changed if the location designated by the bibliographer or profile conflicts with those noted below. This applies to all materials, whether ordered or gifts.
