

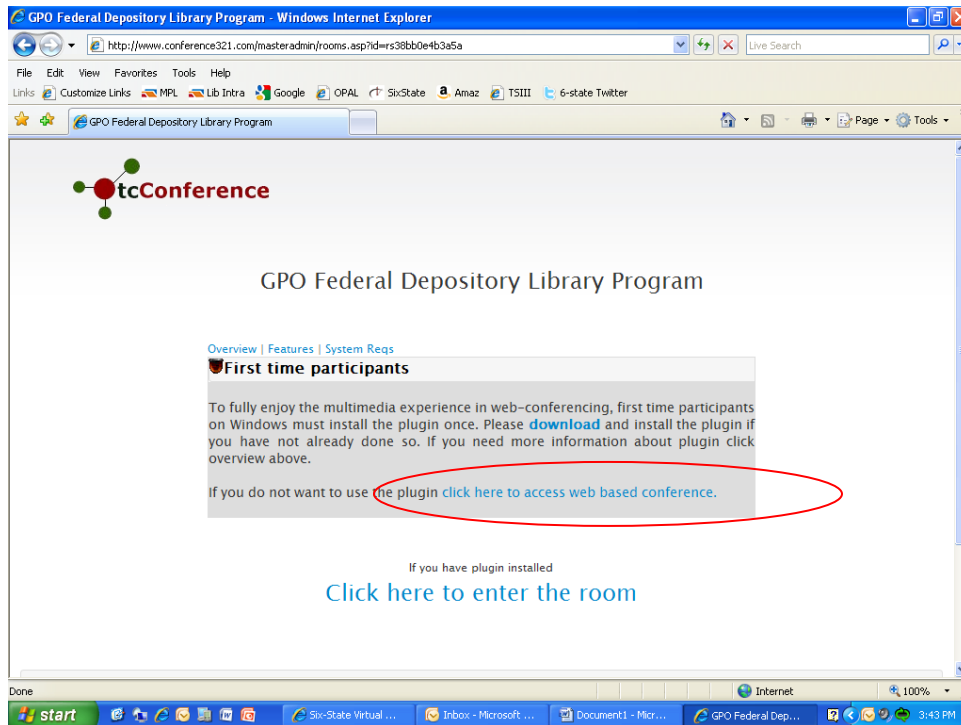
Web Based Conference

We highly urge you to load the OPAL plug-in before joining the meeting room for the conference. However, if you're unable to participate using it, you may be able to join in via Web Based Conference access. This is java and may or may not work on your screen. The speaker will see your name with WEB following your login: (Carol Jones NM WEB)

Features that may not work:

- Speaking during the presentation
- Hearing the presenter
- Seeing the live chat
- IN conclusion, the plugin works best!

Way the screen works:

Notice the chat box – and your chat entry field (under “Chat Message:”). That’s the area of the screen where chat is entered and displayed.

Below that is information on people in the room.

Note that your controls are in a different location than those of participants/speakers who entered the “plug-in” way – **YOUR chat tools are on the right side**, theirs are on the left. Please don’t be distracted or confused if the speaker asks you to do something on the left.

We’ve also determined that you may be unable to speak (it is often difficult to speak) in this particular platform. You may also have trouble hearing the speaker.
