Historical Background:

Mandell Creighton (1843–1901), historian and Anglican churchman, served as bishop of Peterborough (consecrated in 1891), then as bishop of London in 1897. His work as an historian focused upon the Catholic Church during the later Middle Ages and the Renaissance during periods of Reformation and Counter or Catholic Reformation. Regarding the scope of his work and his reputation as an historian, C.M.D. Crowder notes that:

[T]he five volumes of *The History of the Papacy* are certainly his chief contribution, a work which stands up to critical scrutiny for its judgements, selection, and compression; but he was equally concerned with the impact of the Reformation in England. While far from confined to ecclesiastical questions, his successive studies of Wolsey (1888) and the reign of Elizabeth I (1896)—a period which he noted as barely suitable for undergraduate study because everything in England was then undergoing such rapid change—are limpid interpretations of those times, and influenced the understanding and curiosity of the generation which followed him. As well as editing the *English Historical Review* for its first five years, he edited two series of historical outlines. (C. M. D. Scope and Provenance of the Collection:

The Creighton Collection holds over 400 titles and a wide range of pamphlets (approximately 142 in number), the majority pertaining to religious history. Most of the works held in the collection focus upon the history of the Catholic Church and the papacy. A number of these examine challenges to church doctrine and practice, including early fifteenth-century opposition presented by Jan Hus (d. 1415) and the later sixteenth-century Reformation initiated by Martin Luther. A number of other works address European history, particularly that of Italy. Titles are in Latin, German, Italian, French, and English. The collection holds titles dating from the late fifteenth century (*Historia rerum ubique gestarum, cum locorum descriptione non finita Asia Minor*, written by Manthen de Gherretzen and *Historia rerum ubique gestarum, cum locorum descriptione non finita Asia Minor incipit*, by Pope Pius II, both published in 1477, for example) through the early twentieth century (*Life and Letters of Mandell Creighton*, 1904, written by Louise Creighton).

According to Prof. Emeritus Boyd Hill of the History Department on 16 February 1994, the collection was probably purchased by the Libraries circa 1937. It was transferred into Special Collections in February 1965 according to the Department's Annual Report.

Arrangement:

The collection is uncataloged. It arranged by main entry.
